RE: SUPPORT Senate Bills 337 & 338

Dear Chairman and Members of the Committee,

I am a resident of District 33, president of Bicycle Advocates for Annapolis and Anne Arundel County ("BikeAAA"), Chair of the recently appointed Anne Arundel County Bicycle Advisory Commission and an avid Maryland cyclist for over 20 years. On behalf of BikeAAA and its more than 700 members, I support Senate Bills 337 and 338. Maryland has a strong history of support for safe bicycling but has slipped recently in the League of American Bicyclists state ranking from #7 to #10. Safe biking is important not only for Maryland's health and environment, it is also critical for economic competitiveness as millennials favoring active transportation over cars choose places to live, work and start businesses. It is also a transportation equity concern for Marylanders for whom a bike is the only affordable option.

- 1. SB337 clarifies the current ambiguous laws for drivers and bicyclists to enable safe passage of bicyclists through crosswalks. This is especially important where trail users cross roads.**
- 2. SB338 allows the use of improved pedestrian and bicyclist activated signals at crossings**

Safe bicycling promotes health, reduces traffic, improves the environment and stimulates economic growth. To encourage more bicycle transportation, Maryland must make crossings safer. We urge your support for passage of SB337 and SB 338.
